WORKSHOP ON MORAL VALUES



WORLD POLIO DAY




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MATHEMATICS DAY


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VEER BAAL DIWAS

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




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CALLIGRAPHY

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


MATHEMATICS QUIZ

As a part of extended learning Maths Quiz was conducted in our school . Students of Grade 4 and Grade 5 participated in the Quiz.




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NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY (SCIENCE QUIZ)
